## LOCAL LEADERS ENDORSE PALMESANO FOR STATE ASSEMBLY

Will also chair, coordinate Palmesano campaign in 136th

Corning, N.Y., (August 10, 2010)—Community leaders in Steuben and Yates Counties are endorsing Steuben County Legislator Phil Palmesano (R-Corning) for the Republican Nomination in New York’s 136th Assembly District, the Palmesano Campaign announced today.

The local leaders will also serve as “Co-chairs” of Palmesano’s Campaign and help coordinate and direct his efforts in Steuben and Yates Counties.
